RISING STAR NOMINEE – WILL STRATFORD

AFL Sydney would like to congratulate Sydney University player William Stratford who has been adjudicated as the Men's Rising Star for Round 3.

The 20-year old has played 52 games with the Club across his 4 seasons, mainly as a key forward in the Under 19's 'Colts'.

In 2015, Stratford suffered an ACL injury that sidelined the Kareela local for 1 ½ seasons.

Stratford returned to the field this year, making his highly anticipated return in Round 1 against Western Suburbs, where he kicked 3 goals.

In his first 3 games of 2017, Stratford has kicked 7 goals, including 3 goals on the weekend in the Student's win over UNSW/ES.

With positions in the SUANFC Premier Division hard to come by, Stratford has certainly earned his spot in the Student's forward line, and will be one to watch for the remainder of the 2017 season.
