



The Sydney University Australian National Football Club (SUANFC) is seeking proposals for the provision of sports medicine and physiotherapy services (“the Services”) to SUANFC.

SUANFC consists of eleven grades that compete across the North East Australian National Football League (NEAFL) and AFL Sydney competitions. SUANFC has 300+ active athletes competing across all grades.

Work Scope:

The Sponsor/Partner will provide the Services as outlined below;

1. Provide the following staff on game days (estimated at 20 game days, home and away);
  - I. NEAFL: Head Physiotherapist, 1 x Sports Trainer, 4 x Sports Trainers (Interns) (est. 6 hours total) and Sports Doctor (home games only, est. 3 hours total)
  - II. Premier Division (Men & Women): Physiotherapist (est. 5 hours total)
  - III. AFL Sydney (x 7): Sports Trainer (est. 3 hours per game. Total hours for trainers rostered on consecutive games may be reduced)
2. Provide the following staff at in-season training ( estimated at 20 weeks);
  - I. NEAFL: Head Physiotherapist, 1 x Sports Trainer (Mon & Wed) (est. 3 hours)
  - II. Premier Division: Physiotherapist (Men – Mon, Women - Tue) (est. 3 hours)
  - III. AFL Sydney: Sports Trainer (Mon/Wed/Thu) (est. 3 hours)
3. Provide the following staff at pre-season training (Estimated: NEAFL 22 weeks / Premier Division 12 weeks / AFL Sydney 3 weeks);
  - I. NEAFL: Head Physiotherapist, 1 x sports trainer (Tues, Thu & Sat) (est. 2 hours)
  - II. Premier Division: Physiotherapist (Tue), sports trainer (Thu) (est. 2 hours)
  - III. AFL Sydney: 1 x sports trainer (Mon / Wed) (est. 2 hours)
4. Oversee the administration and management of all sports medicine and physiotherapy services including but not limited to;
  - I. Rostering
  - II. Staff inductions and training
  - III. Equipment management
  - IV. Payroll
5. Provide appropriate materials (strapping tape, massage tables, heat rub, etc.) to a professional standard
6. Provide clinic services to SUANFC athletes (physiotherapy and sports medicine)

Proposals must include;

1. Breakdown of game day services as ‘per game’(including varied game length options)
2. Breakdown of training services as ‘per training’(2 and 3 hour training options)
3. Breakdown of materials to be provided and level of quality of materials
4. Proposal of costs incurred by SUANFC
5. Proposal of costs incurred by SUANFC athletes (per clinic visit)
6. Proposed level of experience of head physiotherapist, physiotherapist, head sports trainer and sport trainers
7. Proposed training and development of sports trainers
8. Proposal of level of cash sponsorship

## Notes:

- NEAFL and Premier Division (men & women) cannot be the same physiotherapist due to clashes in trainings and matches
- Interstate travel will be required by the NEAFL physiotherapist and sports trainer
- All Sports Trainers must be accredited (Level 1 Sports Trainer)
- Cash sponsorships benefits can be further negotiated with the club (e.g. signage, apparel branding, etc.).
- SUANFC shall not be liable for any medical equipment or time of travel.
- SUANFC shall be liable for interstate travel and accommodation as organised by SUANFC, SUANFC shall not be liable for any additional travel expense
